Job Purpose

To deliver peer education sessions using the Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE) to Adolescent Girls and young women (AGYW). Through the Skillshare led Consortium (Skillshare Lesotho, Sesotho Media and Development and Lesotho National Olympic Committee (LNOC), Project (*Stepping up universal access: A multi-Sectoral partnership to HIV prevention at the community level*) focuses on up scaling AGYW Prevention interventions and access to health services across the four districts in Lesotho being Mafeteng, Mochale's Hoek, Qacha's Nek and Quthing.

Main Duties and Responsibilities:

- Commit to being a Peer Educator for at least 12 months. (July 2017- June 2018).
- To identified adolescent Girls and Young women and boys.
- Mobilize participants for the rollout sessions and assist with conducting outreach and promote clinic services.

- Serve at least 6 hours per day.
- Participate and complete required Peer Educator trainings and periodic training updates.
- Draw up weekly plans and submit weekly reports to the District Coordinator.
- Conduct daily SBCC sessions for out of school youth and conduct rollout sessions using the Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE).
- Ensure that participants attend sessions consistently.
- Complete a daily registration capturing all participants for each meeting conducted.
- Pass on the daily completed participants registers capturing all participants of the meetings to the team leaders /or District Coordinator.
- Organize special events within the communities.
- Establish and support Youth Action Committees and Youth Support groups within the communities.
- Assist with planning and presenting of sexual health education workshops and activities.
- Assist in designing various types of health education materials (flyers, pamphlets, posters, etc.).
- Attend mandatory monthly meetings and all other meetings as the District Coordinator may request from time to time.
- Ensure that you meet the set targets (not less than 50 participants reached per month with the CSE curriculum, 40% of health and non-health referrals, 80% referred for HTS and they know their results).
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Requirements

- Must at least completed High School or college (19 - 25 years old).
- ****The age requirement is flexible for a very mature and eager teen****
- Interested in sexual health issues relating to youth.
 - Comfortable with public speaking, especially speaking to peers their age about sex and sexuality.
 - Mature, reliable, and responsible.
 - Experience in peer education related activities

Expertise and Skills

- Ability to read and write
- Fluency in both Sesotho and English language
- Good community mobilisation skills
- Ability to facilitate sessions for young people
- Exceptional verbal, written and presentation skills
- Ability to work with large and diverse teams of young people
- Ability to work effectively under pressure both independently and as part of a team
- Ability to work in a multi-ethnic and multi-cultural setting

Training

- Training sessions will be provided in order to increase knowledge and presentation skills around HIV and TB prevention.
